5. District Councillors Report

Cllr Sollom's written report was noted. It was reported that there had been some significant development for Trumpington Meadows put forward in the Local Plan call for sites.

1. Cambridge South Station

M Blissett and Sophie Moeng, from Network Rail, presented the updates to the Cambridge South Station project. The northern most option was being progressed as it has the best links with the Guided Busway and the Hospital Access Road. It was reported that cycle route NCN11 would be temporarily diverted during the development.

Concerns about the security for bicycles parked at the station were raised. The issues would be fed back to the project.

General safety issues surrounding the area were raised; including lighting, CCTV and on site security personnel. A balance between security and preserving the park needs to be found, British Transport Police are being consulted and the concerns will be noted.

9. East West Rail and Cambridge Approaches Group

The Chairman reported on the Cambridge Approaches meeting that he attended. The route options were discussed and it was noted that the closest option was at the end of the nature reserve near Harston. It was reported that another group may be formed by Comberton Parish Council and surrounding parishes. The Consultations are planned for next year.

It was noted that TM DAG are handling most of the issues with Barratt Homes.
